



TOTAL BUDGET: 3,4 BEUR
WIDENING 3 BEUR – ERA 0,4 BEUR

WIDENING PART

Significant disparities of R&I performance within the EU and low participation of some countries in FPs due to:

- reduced access to international networks
- system learning effects
- problems with information, communication and training
- insufficient national R&D investments
- lack of synergies between national research systems and EU research landscape

ERA PART-SwafS in H2020 + new topics

Reforming and enhancing the EU R&I system - calls structured around 4 strands corresponding to 4 objectives of the new ERA:

- 1. Prioritise investments and reforms
- 2. Improve access to excellence
- 3. Translate R&I results into the economy
- 4. Deepening the ERA
- principle of excellence remains the cornerstone for all investments under ERA









WIDENING INSTRUMENTS

- Continuation in HORIZON EUROPE (2021-2027) new elements and instruments
 - Widening countries in HORIZON: 15 MS (13 NMS + PT and EL) + 9 EU Outermost regions + AC
- Advancing Europe Package
 - Cross-cutting widening measures
 - HOP ON FACILITY (accession of one additional partner from a WC to consortium funded under Pillar 2 or EIC Pathfinder with a valid GA without any WC partner) (+)
 - RECOGNITION OF PARTICIPATION (certificate for WC coordinators)
 - MATCHMAKING (Joint Brokerage Events with Pillar 2 clusters, study visits)
 - PROPOSAL REVIEW / CHECK (trainings, professional reading)

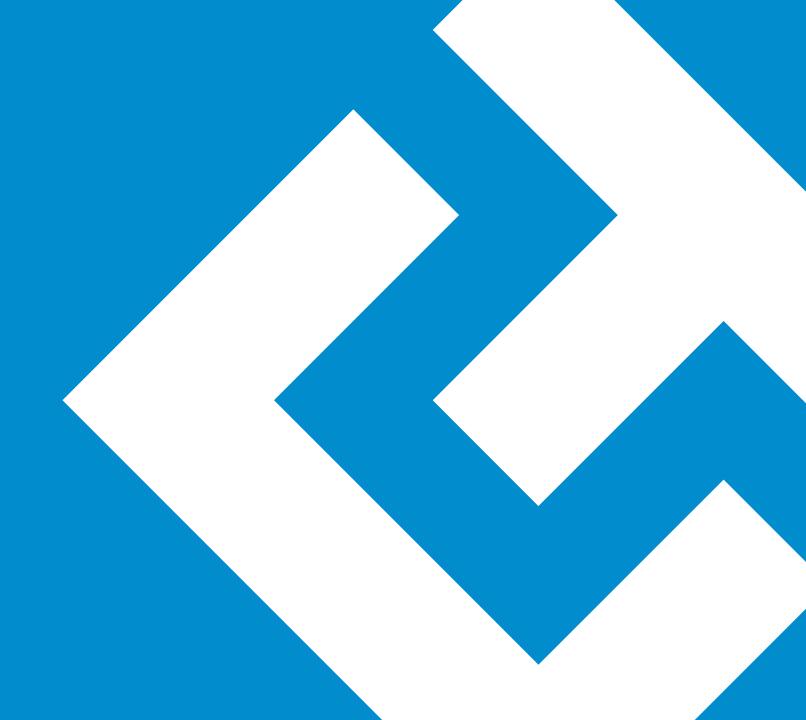
NEW ELEMENT – ELIGIBILITY OF R&I COSTS

Regulation establishing HORIZON, Article 2 – Definitions, paragraph (25h)

"coordination and support action" means an action contributing to the objectives of the HORIZON programme, excluding research and innovation activities, except when undertaken under the component "widening participation and spreading excellence" of the part "Widening Participation and Strengthening the ERA"; …

Research and innovation costs are eligible in CSA for Widening instruments

TEAMING FOR EXCELLENCE



TEAMING 2021-2022

116 PROPOSALS SUBMITTED (CZ - 10)
32 PROJECTS PASSED TO STAGE 2 (THRESHOLD 8,5) CZ - 4

RATIONALE

- MAIN AIM institution building: create new centres of excellence or substantially upgrade existing ones (2 phases abolished)
- Two-stage evaluation process (more details in FAQs)
- Complementary funding from other sources at least equal to the requested HORIZON grant (letter of commitment for the 2nd stage)
- Seal of Excellence to applications exceeding all evaluation thresholds but cannot be funded due to lack of budget available
- A research component up to 10% may include preparatory research project



- + surrounding ecosystems, including nonuniversity research centres

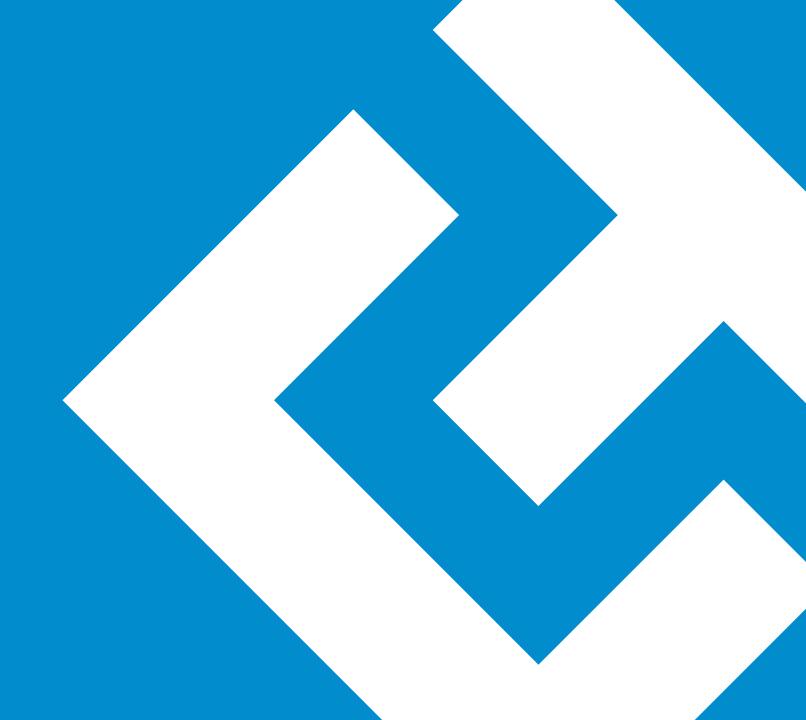

RATIONALE

- MAIN OBJECTIVES:
 - Raise excellence in science and in value creation through deeper and geographically inclusive cooperation in alliances of HEIs with a particular focus on widening countries;
 - Improve global competitiveness and visibility of EU HEIs, creating critical mass in key areas such as the green transition and HE Mission areas
- Inclusion of research activities with a centre of gravity in widening countries, e.g. budget allocation of at least 70% to participants from Widening countries
- Costs of research activities including equipment are limited to a maximum of 20% of the total budget
- Integrated collaboration between institutions and with other actors in local ecosystems

 - Special focus on strengthening the research management and administrative skills
- A research component up to 30% may include exploratory research project (dedicated WP) - at least 70% of the research activities must be allocated to the coordinator







- Proposal must include the accession of one additional partner from a Widening country
- HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-ACCESS-07-01 (including FAQs)
- Opening: 27 January 2022; Deadlines: 20 April 2022 and 10 November 2022
- Overall indicative budget: M€ 40; EU budget per project: M€ 0,2 – 0,5 (allocated to the new partner)
- Expected no. of projects: 80

- List of eligible RIA projects (available under Topic Updates)



Nástroj Hop On je jedním ze čtyř nových průřezových opatření balíčku Advancing Europe Package, který v rámcovém programu Horizont Evropa (HE) doplnil čtyří hlavní nástroje z předchozího programu H2020 (TEAMING, TWINNING, ERA Chairs a program COST). Společně cilí na snížování přetrvávajících rozdílů ve výkonnosti výzkumu a inovací prostřednictvím sdílení znalostí a odborných poznatků napříč EU. Nástroj umožňuje přistoupení jednoho partnera ze skupiny tzv. Widening zemí ke konsorciu kolaborativního projektu HE.

ZPŮSOBILÉ PROJEKTY

O nového partnera z Widening země se mohou ucházet projekty financované v klastrech Piliře 2 (Globální výzvy a konkurenceschopnost) a v EIC Pathfinder v Piliři 3 (Inovativní Evropa) programu HE s již podepsanou grantovou dohodou a bez partnera z jakôkoliv Widening země. Jedná se vždy výhradně o kolaboratívní projekty typu RIA – Research and Innovation Action. Seznam způsobílých projektů je zveřejněn na Portálu pro finanční přiležitosti a veřejně zakázky (FTDP) u výzvy Hop On a je Evropskou komisi aktualizován každy týden. Subjekty z Widening zemí se zájmem o přistoupe-

ní mohou oslovit přímo koordinátora relevantního projektu vyplněním kontaktního formuláře po přihlášení do FTOP (tlačitko Contact u každého projektu).



ERA TALENTS 2022 - NEW

To build R&I support capacity, such as knowledge brokers, data stewards, research infrastructure operators, etc.

RATIONALE

- MAIN AIM to boost interoperability of careers and employability of research and innovation talents across sectors, with a centre of gravity in Widening countries
- Seconded staff must be actively engaged at least 6 months (FTE) at the sending institution before the (first) period of secondment
- Need to provide an estimate of the number of the seconded ERA talents
- Allocate at least 70% of the budget for secondments for the benefit of WCs
- Mandatory return phase for every cross-border secondment from a WC - support for return, incl. salaries, allowed for up to 12 months within grant duration

- HORIZON-WIDERA-2022-TALENTS-03-01
- Opening: 29 June 2022
- Deadline: 15 November 2022
- Overall indicative budget: M€ 24
- Budget per project: M€ 1 3
- Consortium: 1 + 2
- Secondments must last between 3 and 24 months for the same staff member







